Concept of Growth

- GROWTH →1.Refers to an increase in some quantity over time. The quantity can be Physical (e.g. growth in height)
- 2.The term growth is used in purely physical sense. It generally refers to an increase in size, length, height & weight. Changes in the quantitative aspects come into the domain of growth.

Concept Of Development

orderly changes and continuities in the individual that occur between conception and death.

2.is a wider & comprehensive term. It refers to the overall changes in an individual. Growth is one of its parts. Development describes the changes in the organism as a whole and does not list the changes in parts.

Difference between Growth and Development

5. Senescence \rightarrow from 60 to till death

1. Infancy — from birth to 2 years 2. Childhood from 3rd year to 12 years (a) Pre-childhood 3rd year to 6 years (b) Later childhood 7th year to 12 years 3. Adolescence from 13th year to 19 years 4. Adulthood from 20th year to 60 years
